As it is known, in our country, in concerning sections of the circulars no. 2005/2 of 19.04.2005 and no. 2005/8 of 18.10.2005, which were drawn up by our General Directorate and sent to our provincial directorates and which are on the concerning principles of commencing insuredness of citizens of a foreign country transacting businesses stated in the section "II-Those Considered Insured" of Article 24 of the Law no. 1479 and its implementation, it is stated that those of the citizens of foreign countries transacting within the scope of Article 24 of the Law No.1479, who has paid premiums or deductions to legally organized social security institutions before starting their activities in our country both in the country they are citizens thereof and in our country or who receive a disability pension or old age pension or permanent full invalidity pension from such institutions or who has applied for a pension to be granted (excluding those who receive a widow's or orphan's pension or those who receive a temporary or permanent invalidity pension from such institutions), provided they document their condition through the certificates issued by such institution (such documents must be translated into Turkish by the consulates or by the sworn translation offices), will not be considered as insured by our institution by being appraised in accordance with the principles mentioned in paragraph (c ) of the section "II-Those Not Considered Insured" of Article 24 of the Law No. 1479

Depending on the above explanations, Our Provincial Directorates will start to communicate with the citizens of foreign countries who became insured by our institution between 04.10.2000 when they were covered by our insurance because of their commencement of the activities mentioned in Article 24 of the Law No. 1479 and the date when the Circular numbered 2005/2 and dated 19.04.2005 was published, determining whether they have such qualities. Then the insuredness by our institution of those who can document that they carry those qualities will be canceled reckoning from the date of registration of their insuredness by our institution, the healthcare expenses paid but not regarded as deserved will be collected from those who benefited from healthcare services, and, if requested by them, the premiums they paid will be paid them back being considered as unnecessary payment.

I request you to get informed and perform what is required.
